

Any creditors who want to take part in the Creditors' General Meeting shall attend the meeting bearing his/her unique personal identification document and, in the event of a legal person, a copy of the filing with the Commercial Registry Act that grants him powers of management of the company.

If you want to be represented by an agent or legal representative, including a lawyer, you should deliver the legal document making proof of their powers specific to attendance and voting capacity in the Creditors' General Meeting to the Judicial Administration no less than 24 (twenty four) hours before the meeting, and you may, within the same period, indicate where the document can be found within the case records of the judicial recovery.

and the original documents should be delivered on the day of the Creditor's General Meeting.

The labor union may represent their members' credits arising from labor law rights or resulting from injuries at work who do not appear in person or by proxy at the Meeting, provided they present to the Trustee the list of members who they intend to

represent with no less than ten (10) days before the Meeting. The worker who are members of more than one union must inform the Trustee with no less than 24 (twenty four) hours prior to the meeting, which union will represent him/her, otherwise they will not be represented in the Assembly by any of them.

In any case, we strongly advise the creditor or his representative to attend the Creditors' General Meeting at least one hour prior to beginning to sign the attendance list, since the participation of creditors after the meeting begins will not be allowed.
